	<p>Question 6: Removed non-degree seeking students and students with another home campus taking class(es) at Kauai CC.</p> <p>Question 19: Carpentry Technology, Electrical Installation and Maintenance Technology, and Plant Biology and Tropical Agriculture have a standard for graduate job placement; yet there were less than 10 graduates for the reporting years. Hence; these programs were deleted from the table.</p> <p>Question 20: Prior reports were submitted with course counts duplicated by term (Fall/Spring). In our current assessment plan courses are assessed once per academic year so the counts have been reported unduplicated by academic year (creating a lower overall N).</p> <p>Question 21: Prior reports indicate total majors, not programs. Totals have been revised to include counts by major and award type.</p>
