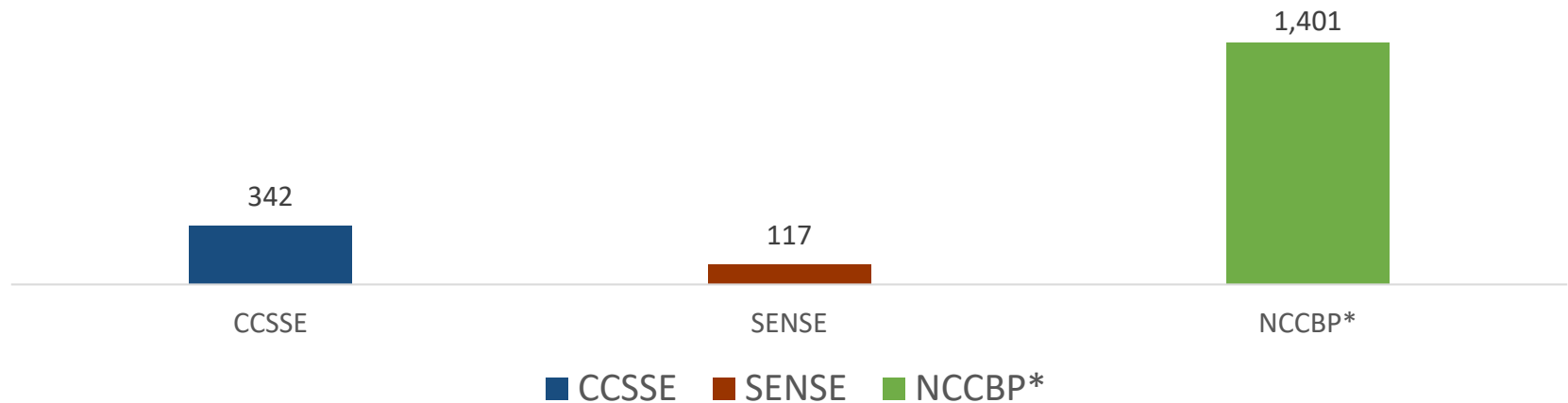

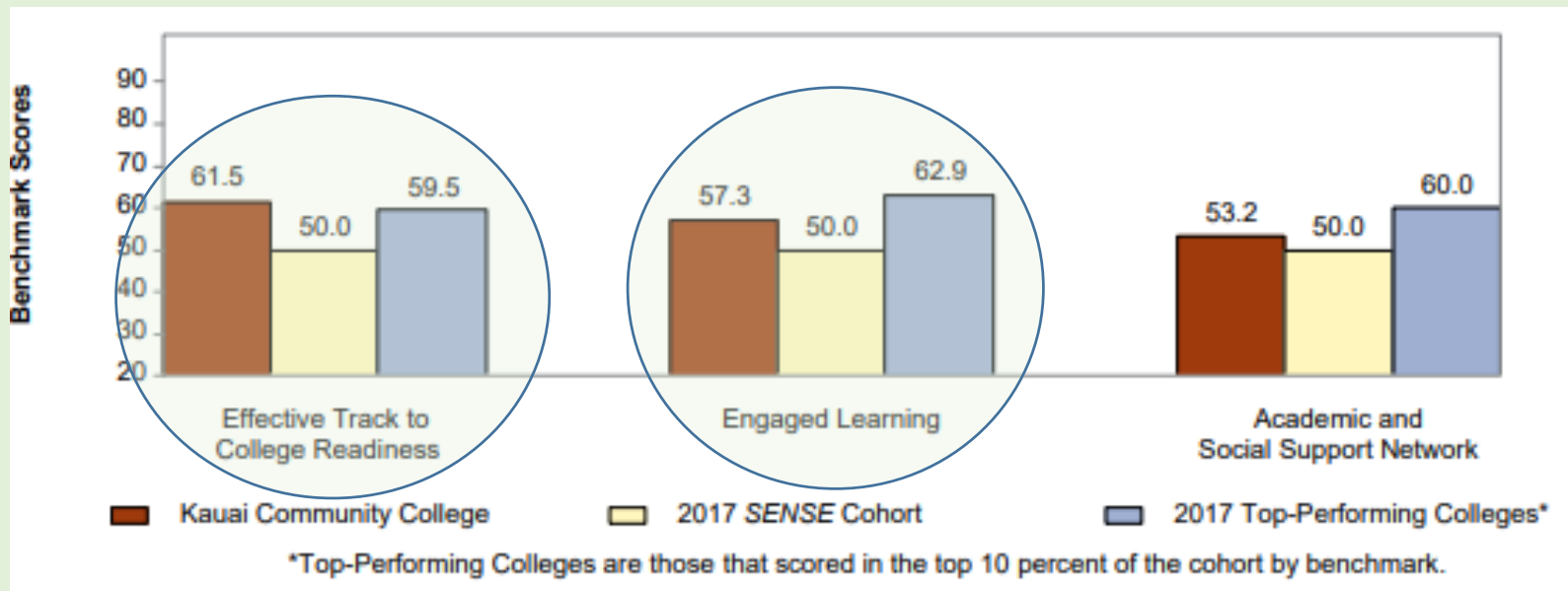

- Overall Kaua'i scored higher means in most areas than the 2017 SENSE Cohort. The following items were significantly higher:



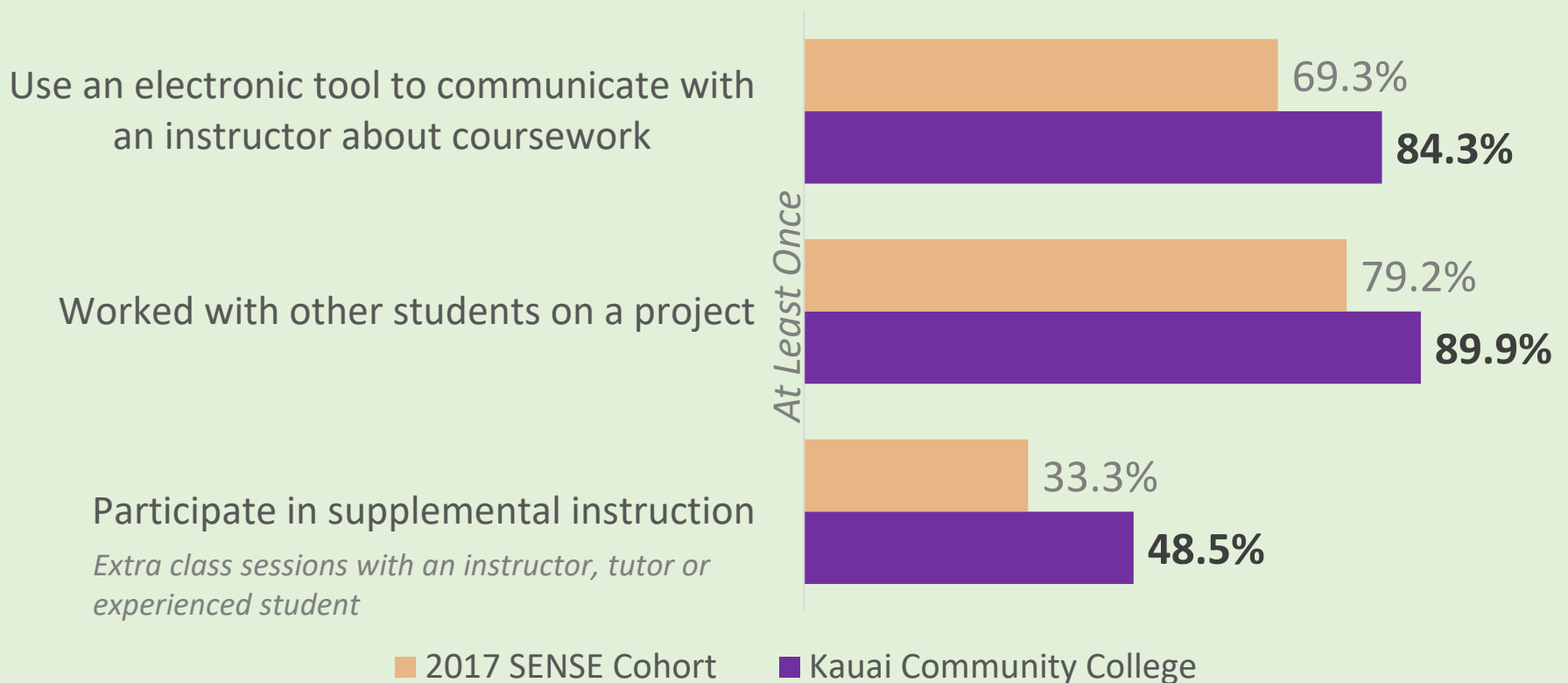
The 2017 *SENSE* Cohort participants include [266 institutions](#) from 41 states and the District of Columbia. **119 colleges are classified as small (<4,500)**, 57 as medium (4,500-7,999), 61 as large (8,000-14,999), and 29 as extra-large institutions (15,000 + credit students).

During the first three weeks of your first semester at this college, about how often did you do the following? (*Engaged Learning*)





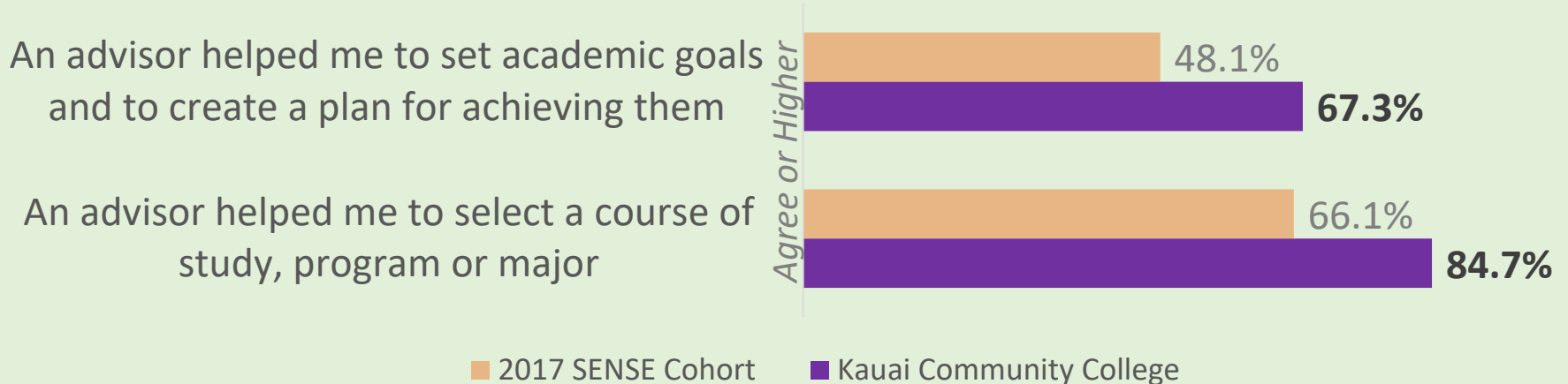

The following items contributed to a score that is above the mean for top performing colleges:

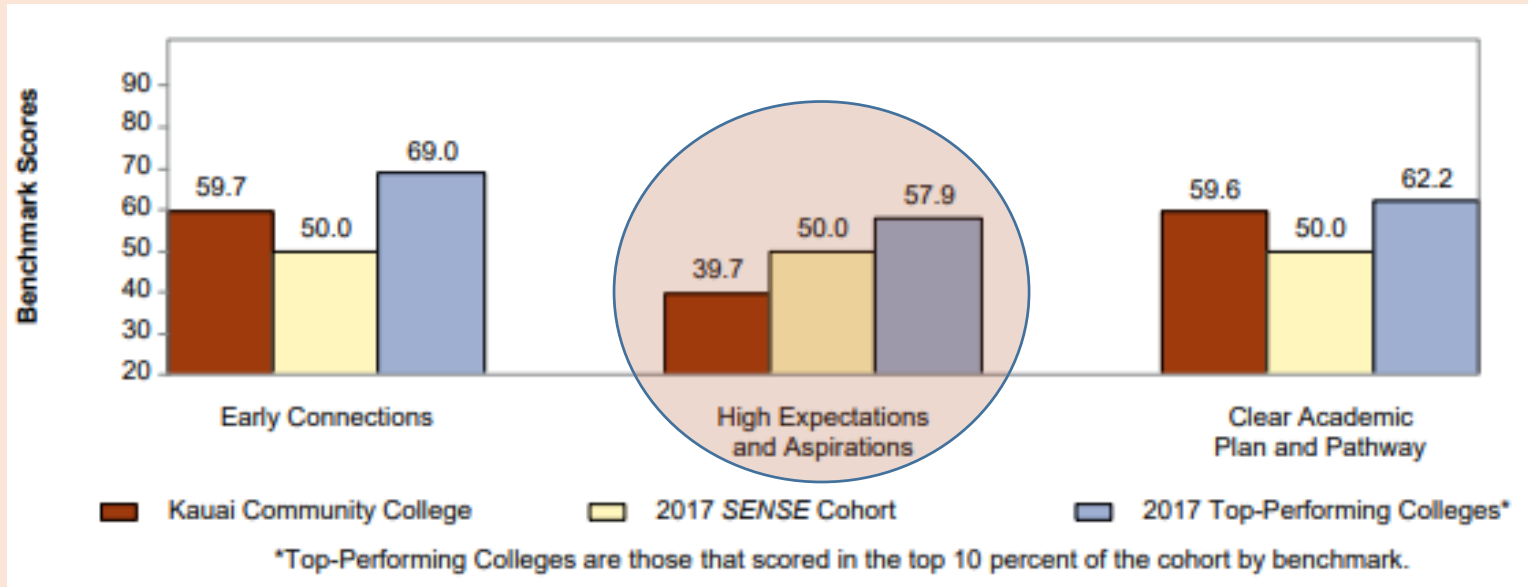

High Expectations and Aspirations area was lower with the following items influencing the score:



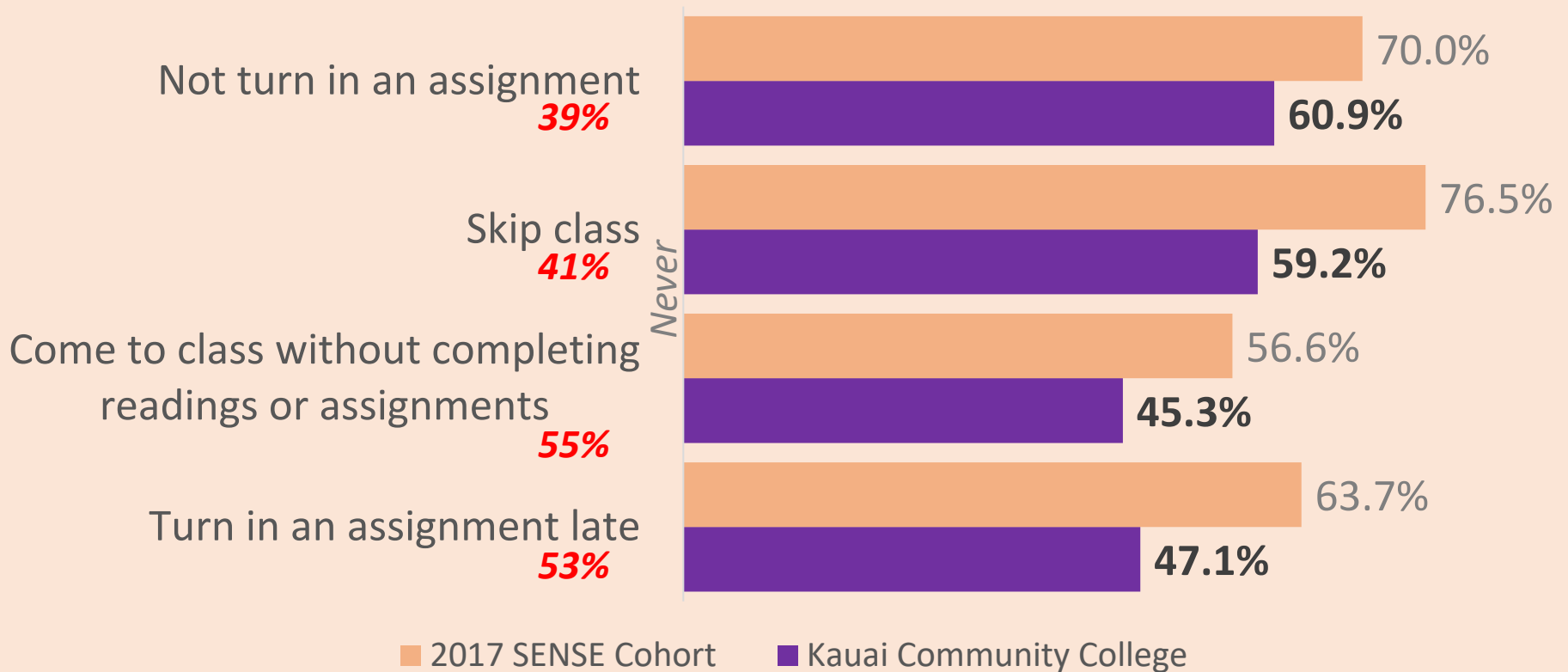
When entering students perceive clear, high expectations from college staff and faculty, they are more likely to understand what it takes to be successful and adopt behaviors that lead to achievement.

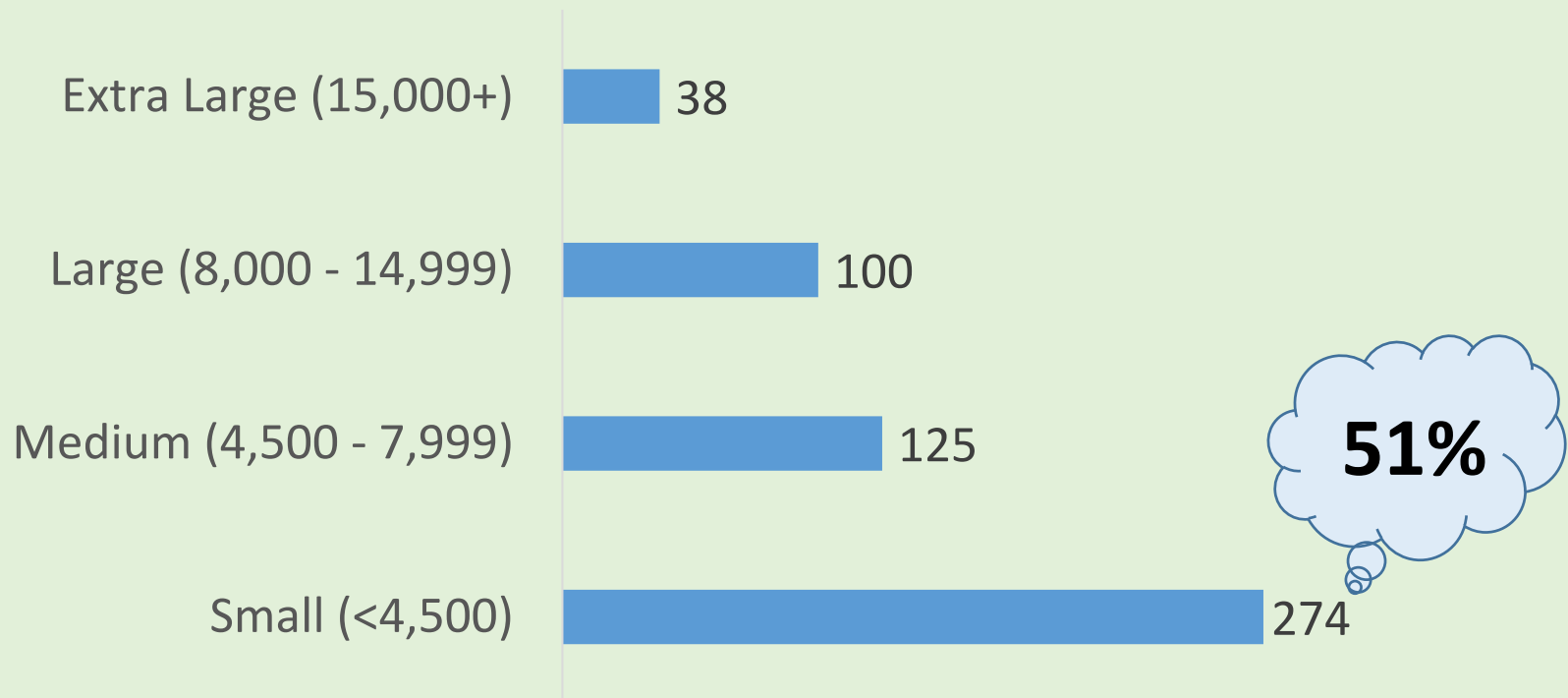
During the first three weeks of your first semester at this college, about how often did you do the following?





2018 CCSSE Cohort

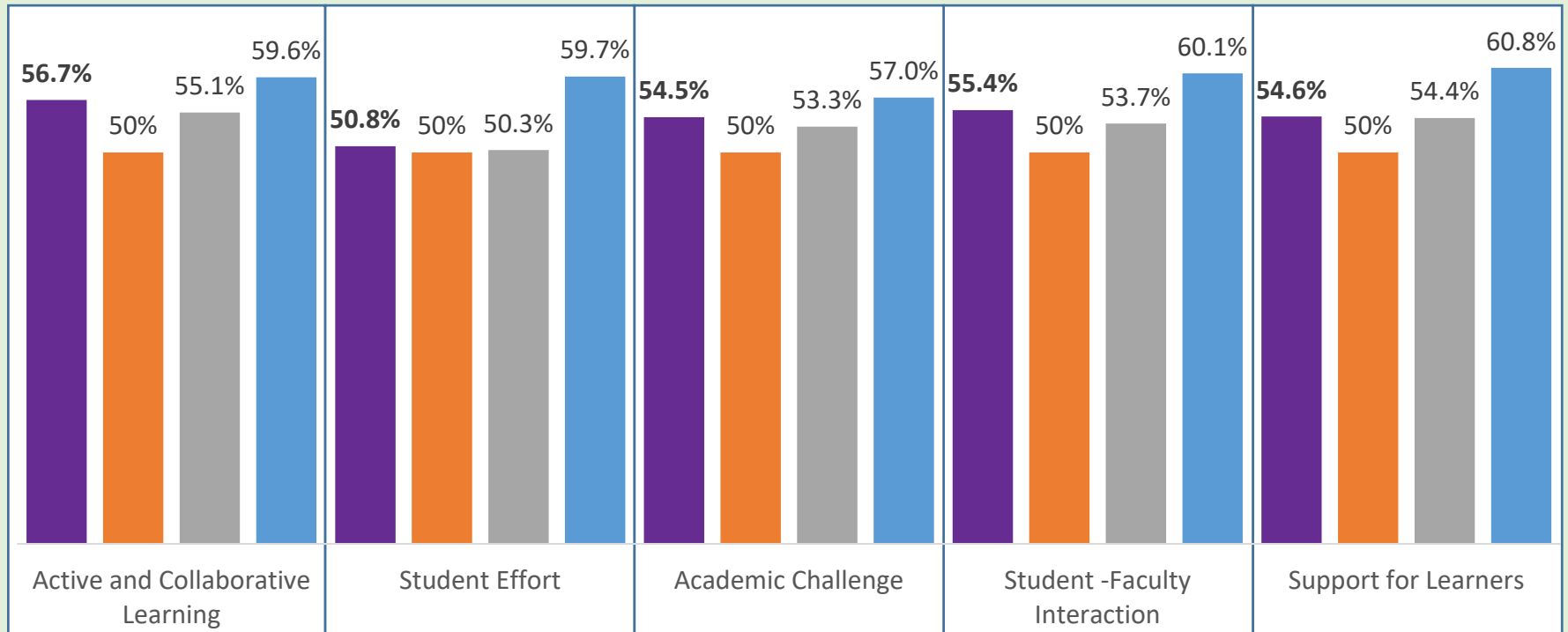

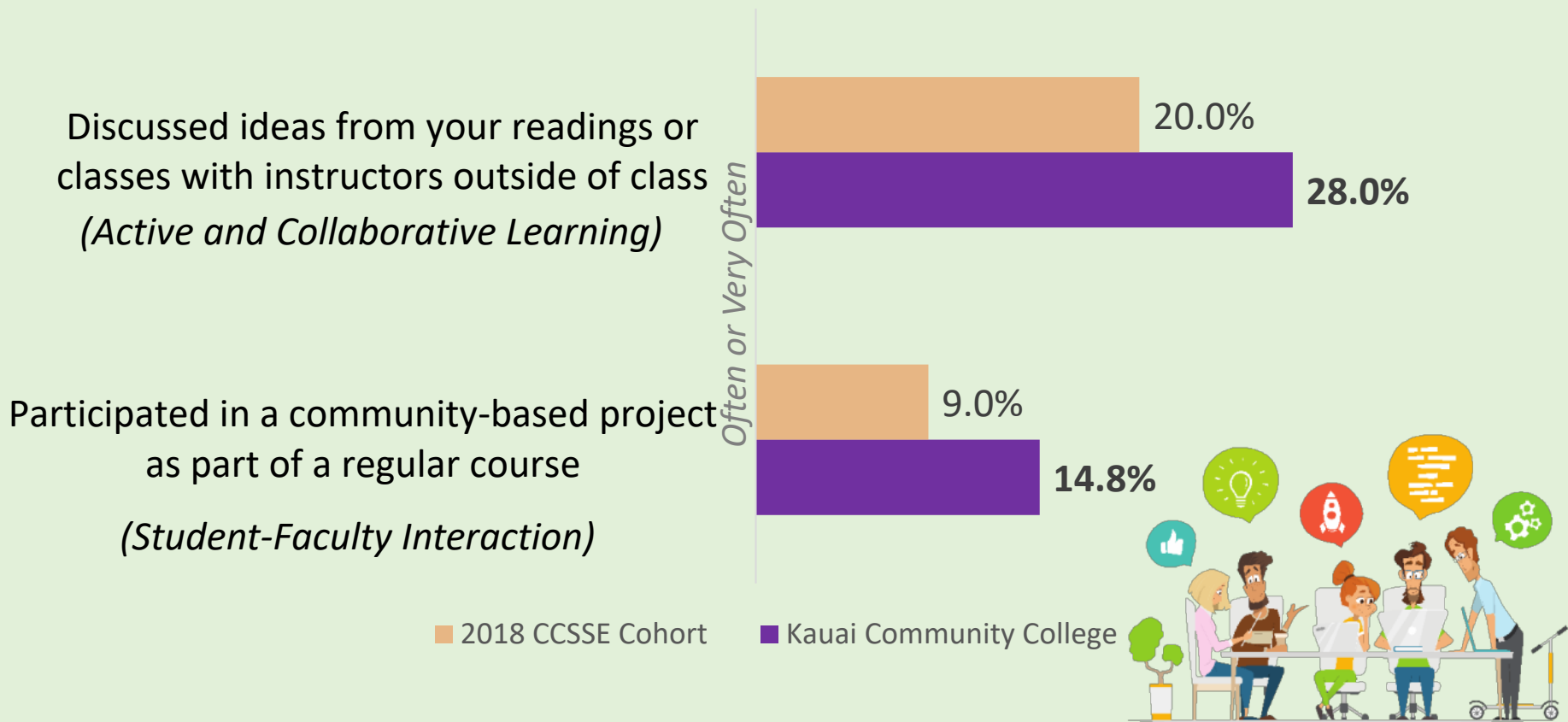

In your experiences at this college during the current academic year, about how often have you done each of the following?



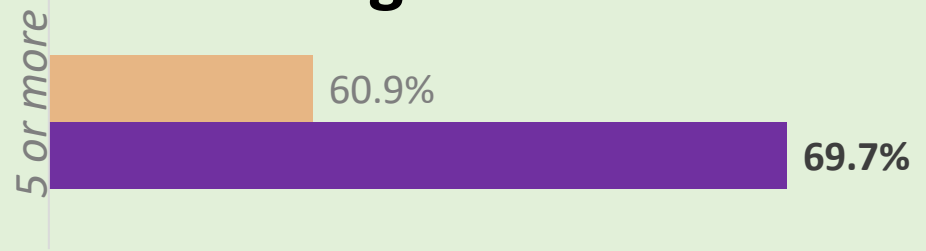

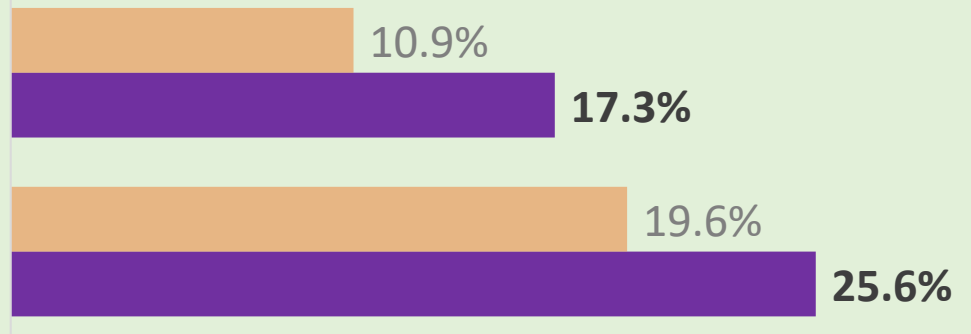
During the current academic year, how much reading and writing have you done at this college?

(Support for Learners)

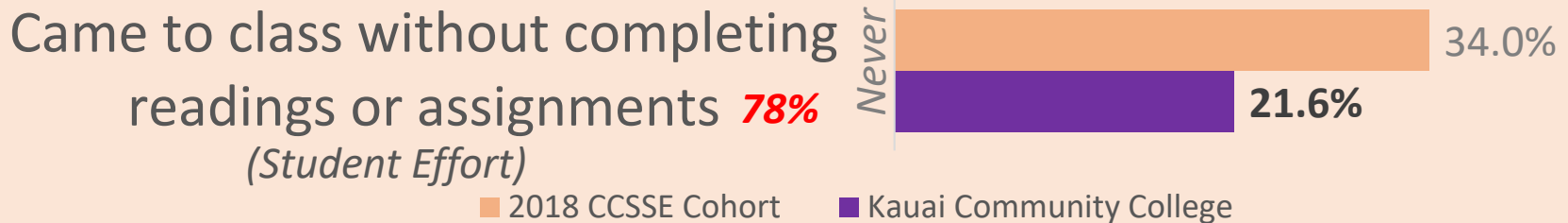

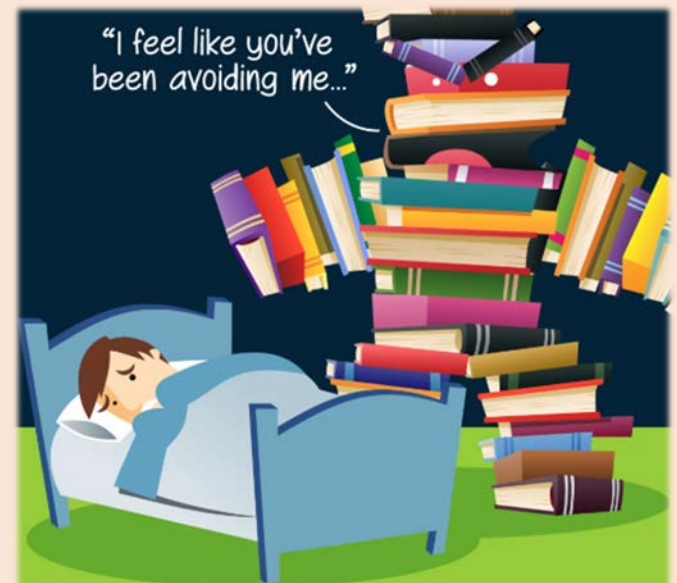
Aspects of Lowest Student Engagement

Students are skipping class or not coming to class prepared



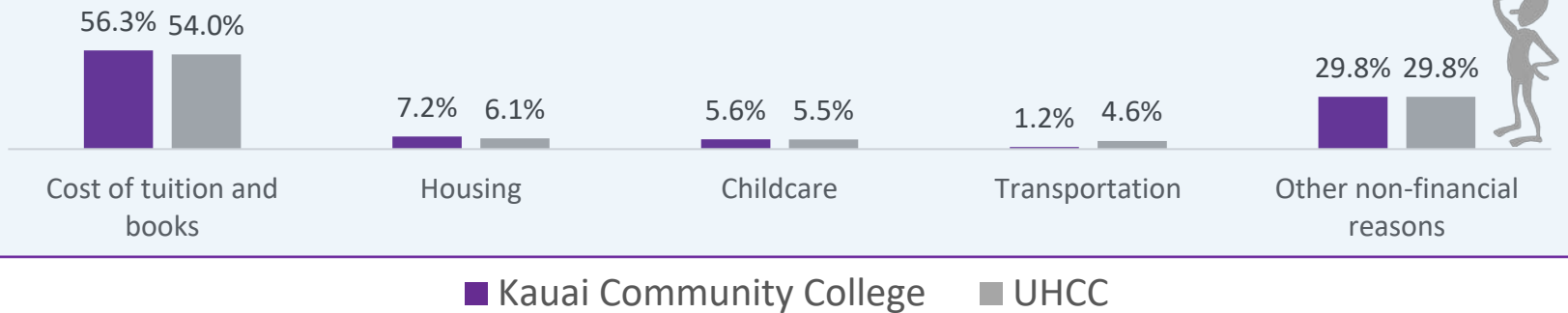

Were you required to meet with an academic advisor prior to registering for your classes your first academic term at this college?

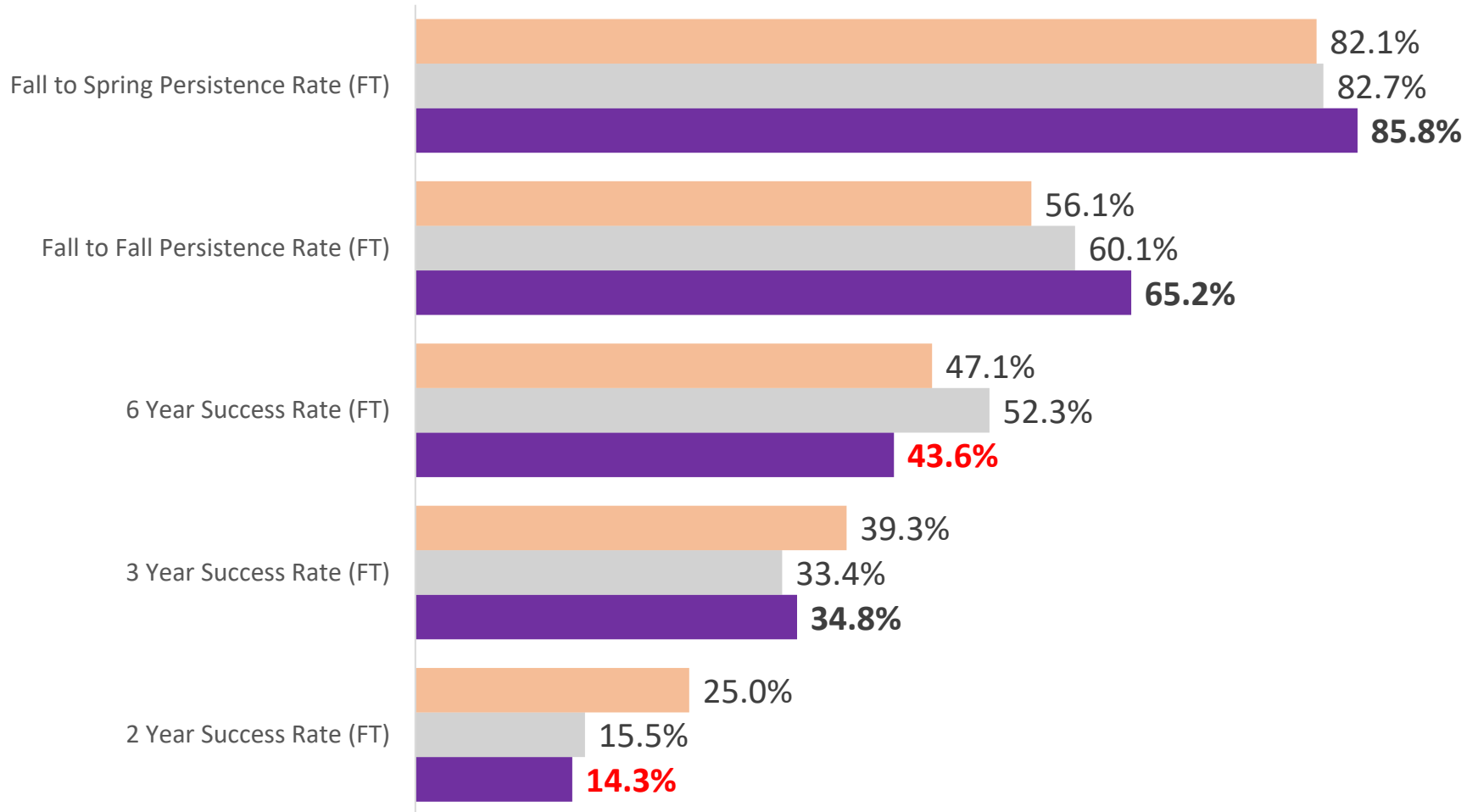


In the past 12 months, have you run out of money and had to rely on outside resources?





Full-Time Student Success

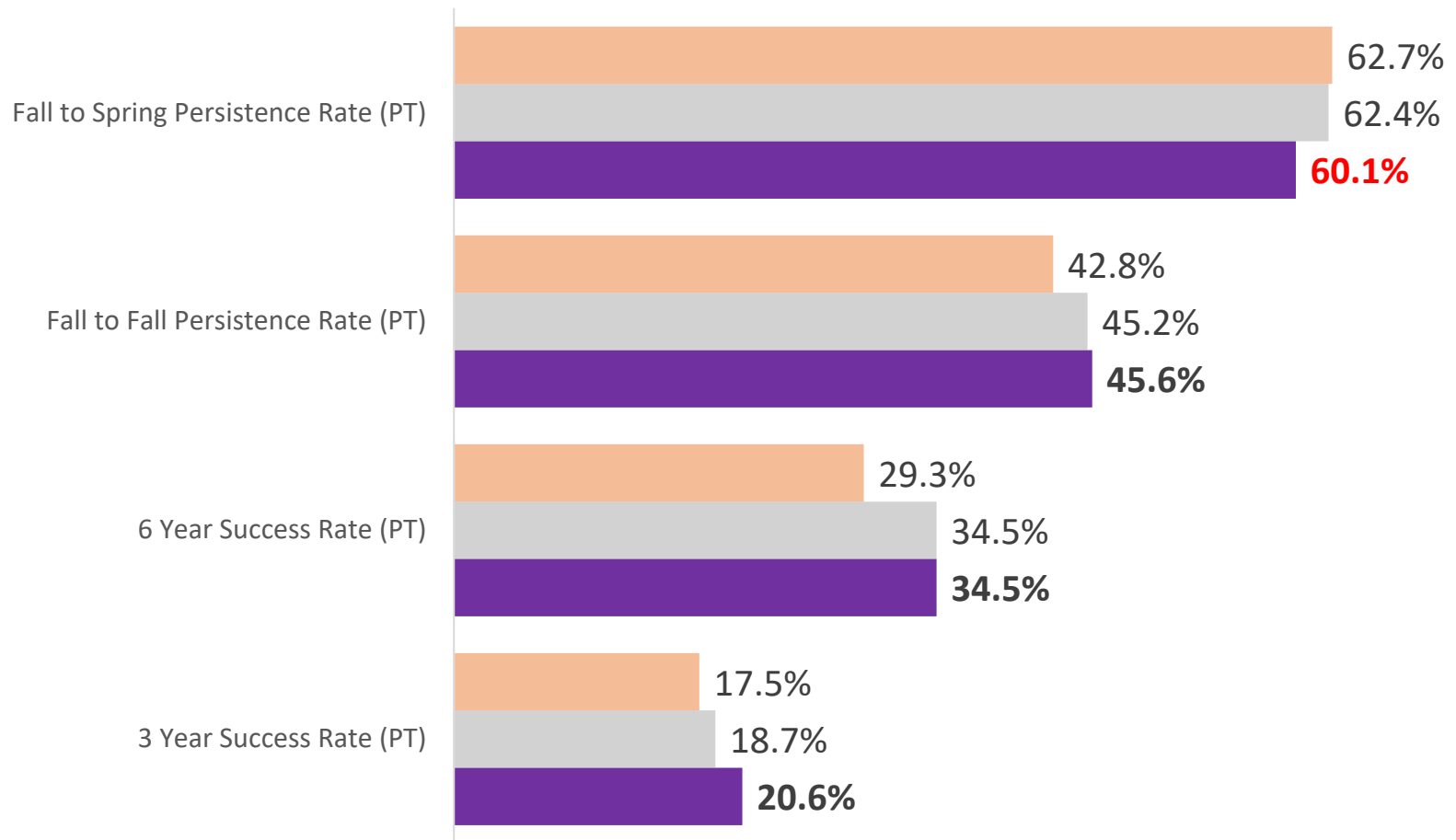
