****HEALTHCARE EXPERIENCE POINT ASSIGNMENT RUBRIC (RANGE 0-5 POINTS)

PURPOSE: The Kauai CC Nursing Program faculty sees the **benefit** of **direct patient care** experience which is founded on candidates' providing Activities of Daily living (ADL) care and practicing therapeutic communication skills; what (certified) nurse aides are trained to do and practice on a daily basis. The **aim** of this recommendation is to have incoming students more comfortable and familiar in the clinical setting because they already have **PRACTICE experience** with interacting and engaging with patients in a formal clinical setting. Nursing faculty have found that this gives practiced students an advantage over students with little or no experience, in RELATING to patients/residents and what direct care is, means, and how it is evaluated through performance measures (time management, organizational skills, and prioritizing).
